



HOW TO REMEMBER CANINE COMPANIONS FOR INDEPENDENCE IN YOUR WILL OR LIVING TRUST

The most common way people remember Canine Companions for Independence in a will or living trust is through a charitable bequest. Following are examples of how to indicate a general or undesignated gift to Canine Companions for Independence.

“I give, devise and bequeath to Canine Companions for Independence, Inc., Tax ID# 94-2494324, located at P. O. Box 446, Santa Rosa, CA 95402, (the sum of \$_____) or (state a percentage of your residuary estate, or designate real and personal property, including exact location) for the benefit of its general purposes (or specify the specific CCI region or program you wish to support).”

This is merely a suggested wording; **please consult your attorney or an estate planning professional when preparing legal documents.**
